500m upstream course

3 entries required for an event: 2 at the committee's discretion.

Senior events will be split into bands against competitors of similar ranking index. The aim will be for no less than 4 and no more than 8 per band but racing against an appropriate ranking will take priority.

Masters crews where an event cannot be formed through a handicap, will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index unless they specify otherwise.

Juniors of J15 and above without opposition and unable to move up will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index.

Double up in divisions to MAXIMISE YOUR RACES

The committee reserves the right to cap, combine or delete Events to adjust the length of the programme

Masters handicap classifications may be applied depending on entries.
Events may be combined or withdrawn if there are fewer than 3 entries.
Please state if you do not wish to be placed in a higher status event.
Entries J13 and above only.

Entries scratched after the draw will not receive a refund. In the event that the Regatta is cancelled, refunds of race fees will be made proportionately after deduction of unavoidable race expenses.

The Crew Ranking Index will be used as a guide to assign entries to the appropriate Event Band

BR Masters' Handicaps will be applied

Winners will be required to produce racing licences before the presentation of prizes

BROE2 will remain open for substitutions until 10pm Fri 10th Aug and it is the responsibility of the club coaches/administrators to ensure that any substitutions are recorded

Adaptive Events

- The races will take place over a 500m course.
- LTA, TA and AS offered in 2x and 1x.
- Please select Open AR-O 1x on BROE2 for all Adaptive 1x entries; we will split into separate Men's, Women's and Junior 1x events to be run on a time handicap basis - Please select Open AR-O 2x for Supported Adaptive 2x entries; we will split into appropriate events to be run on a time handicap basis.
- Adaptive events and timetabling will be adjusted to suit entries following consultation with coaches.
- Please contact Entries Secretary for more information.

Explore Events

- Explore events will be run as a Primary repechage event over 500m, to provide at least two races per crew where there are more than 2 entrants.
- Restricted to new rowers who have taken up rowing since May 2016 or have not previously won at a previous Explore event and do not hold British Rowing points.
- Entrants must be Silver BR members.
- To ensure a fair race, stable boats should be used by all crews entering this race.
- Maidenhead can provide stable boats and cox if required.
- No British Rowing points are awarded.
- Entries must be made and paid for by the closing date, and may be sent in by e-mail, or post, containing names, contact details and British Rowing numbers, to the Entries Secretary.

Doubling-up/Boat sharing

- We welcome doubling-up in division to maximize your races.
- We can only ensure first rounds of doubled-up crews don't clash. The problem lessens as crews are knocked out but clashes may be unavoidable.
- Should a timing clash emerge in later rounds, contact Race Control as early as you can. They can reschedule subject to your oppositions approval.
- If, taking into account all of the above, you think we have scheduled you in two first round races that are too close to each other please contact us by email before 6pm on Tuesday 2nd and we will try to reschedule.
- Please note any doubling/boat sharing within a division
- Entries may be rejected if the smooth running of the racing programme is compromised.
